

## **How to Use the ATR Network Provider Applications and Enrollment Forms**

### **I. ATR Network Tier 2 Agency/Organization Provider Application for Clinical Treatment and/or Recovery Support**

Use this form for a new agency or organization that is applying to enter the ATR Network. Use this form for an agency that employs multiple staff, and/or provides one or more levels of care, or offers services in several locations (for example, outpatient, intensive outpatient, recovery support and residential programs in different locations).

### **II. ATR Network Tier 2 Small Business Provider Application for Clinical Treatment and/or Recovery Support**

Use this form for a small business or organization that is applying to enter the ATR Network. Use this form for a business with few employees, or employees who work in one location, or offer only one level of care (for example, a small outpatient program, a psychologist, a massage parlor/salon with several employees, etc).

### **III. ATR Network Tier 2 Individual Recovery Support Provider Application**

Use this form for a stand-alone Recovery Support provider who works independently of the tribal ATR system and who is not affiliated with an agency or organization (for example, a self-employed cultural resource person, pastoral counselor, life skills teacher, acupuncturist, etc.). In addition to the application, this person also needs to fill out and include a W9 form and provide proof of current background check. A network provider referring/working with this person could assist in obtaining a background check.

### **IV. ATR Network Staff Enrollment Form**

Use this form for:

a. Clinical Treatment and/or Recovery Support staff that are added to an approved provider list after the initial Tribal or Tier 2 provider application has been submitted. Use this form to enroll new program staff, or to add more staff at any time.

b. Tribal departments with staff that will provide recovery support services such as recreation, culture, education, health, life skills, child care, etc. --- services that will be reimbursed through the tribe's ATR voucher redemption system, under the "Tribal Umbrella."
