Keystone treatment center offers residential and outpatient care for adults, young adults, and teens struggling with alcohol, drug, and gambling addiction as well as providing services for those afflicted with methamphetamine and inhalant abuse, cognitive disorders, and dual diagnosis. The multidisciplinary staff at Keystone Treatment Center includes psychiatrists, medical physicians, a psychologist, certified chemical dependency counselors, full-time certified teachers and native American counselors and cultural advisors. Our treatment programs are based on the 12-step philosophy of Alcoholics Anonymous. Patient care is individualized, length of stay is flexible, and extended treatment can be arranged as needed. Keystone has a Native American Program the addresses the traditional values of the Native American patient. We employ a full-time cultural coordinator that provides guidance for our Native American patients. We also have certified Native American chemical dependency counselors on both the adult and adolescent units.

Native Specific Services-Adult unit:

- ◆ Sweat lodge and talking circle offered weekly
- ◆ Red Road videos and discussion
- ◆ Cultural assessment first week of treatment
- ◆ Individual sessions with a cultural advisor for both adults and teens
- ◆ Singing at key chain event to honor completion of treatment
- ◆ Song and prayer when one having hard time

Native Specific Services-Adolescent unit:
