Behavioral Health Services provides individual, couples', family, and group counseling for people experiencing stressful situations, emotional difficulties, or substance use disorders. We also provide Chemical Dependency Assessments for the courts, and for the Department of State. We are a fully licensed facility for substance abuse services and all clinical staff licensed by the state of Michigan for mental health counseling. Our community liaison worker helps people find residential treatment for substance use disorders. We have a psychiatrist one day a week for medication management and psychiatric assessments. Our prevention program offers educational activities that are culturally specific to promote healthy lifestyles in keeping with Native American values.
