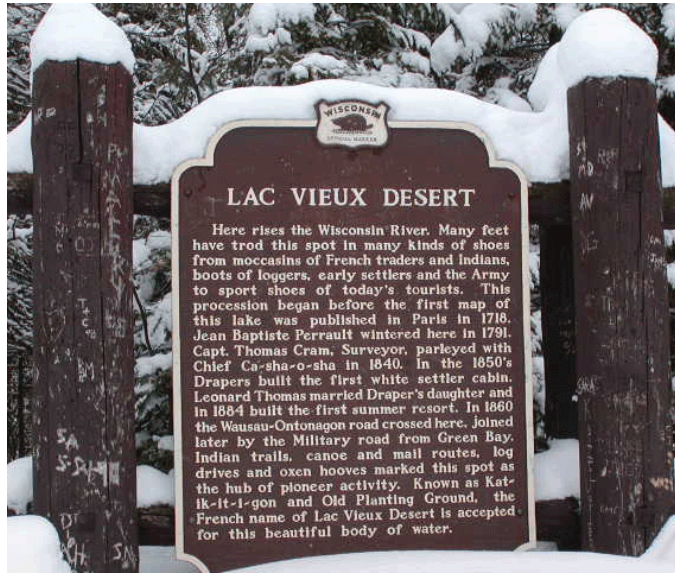

Mission

In partnership with the Tribe, the community, organizations, and individuals, they work to identify, interpret and preserve the culture, traditions, and historic places for the enrichment of the present and the benefit of future generations.

Activities

The Historic Preservation program looks to maintain traditional life ways through:

- General activities
- Conduction of traditional cultural practices
- Language preservation

Protection of traditional sites through:

- General activities
- Participation in tribal/reservation land use planning
- Consultation with Federal/State/local agencies under NEPA, NHPA, etc.
- Oversight of permits for archaeological and other work on reservation lands Policymaking regarding disposition of preservation Plans and ordinances

Research traditional history through:

- General activities
- Oral history collection
- Documentation of traditional objects and activities
- Oversight on historical/archaeological surveys
- Collection of artifacts

Public Interpretation through:

- Oversight of a museum and/or cultural center
- Conduct of exhibitions, art shows, celebrations, etc.
- Planning for museum/cultural center

Education/training through:

- Education of tribal/reservation members in traditional arts and crafts
- Training for Federal/State/local agencies and other non-tribal members
