The Nottawaseppi Huron Band of the Potawatomi Health Department offers person centered treatment to adolescents and adults facing issues related to alcohol and other substances. Our services utilize both western and traditional approaches to healing with emphasis on creating a life lived in balance-Mno Bmadzewen. Upon seeking services, each client will work with their social worker to complete the screening and assessment process. Together, they then develop a plan of treatment specific to their individual needs. Some of the services that Nottawaseppi Huron Band of Potawatomi have to offer are listed below.

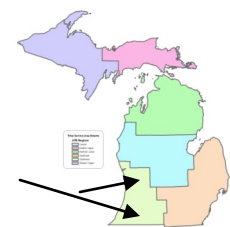
