The Sault American Indian Substance Abuse Program offers person-centered treatment and community based services for alcohol and drug abuse. Our services promote health, dignity, personal growth, and family and community cohesion. Our services emphasize our Native culture, spiritual heritage, and traditional values inherent to the bamaadiziwin lifestyle characterized by a life lived in balance. American Indian Substance Abuse Services are CARF and AAAHC Accredited. The Behavioral Health Program also offers treatment for those with Co-occurring disorders.
