Traditional Medicine Program

The Traditional Medicine Program, established in 1995, was the first tribal traditional medicine program in the United States integrated into a tribal health delivery system. It has become recognized and accepted within the tribal community and has served as a model for traditional medicine programs offered by other tribes. The traditional practitioners and assistants provide services to over 1,800 clients. The demand for services has increased each year of the program's operation.

Traditional Medicine offers holistic Ojibwe services to meet spiritual, mental, physical and emotional needs. Teachings encourage individual responsibility for well being and health. The program also integrates traditional and western medicine practices.
