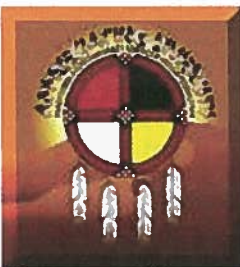

The Sault American Indian Substance Abuse Program offers person-centered treatment and community based services for alcohol and drug abuse. Our services promote health, dignity, personal growth, and family and community cohesion. Our services emphasize our Native culture, spiritual heritage, and traditional values inherent to the bamaadiziwin lifestyle characterized by a life lived in balance. American Indian Substance Abuse Services are CARF and AAAHC Accredited.

### Services Offered

**Eligibility:** Services are available to Native Americans, those who, due to their contact with a Native client must be included in the treatment process, any non-Native woman who is pregnant with a child of Sault Tribal heritage, and anyone in need of emergency care.

**Treatment Setting:** Based on need and other criteria, services are offered in various community locations. Where we are not able to meet a client's needs, appropriate referrals are made.
