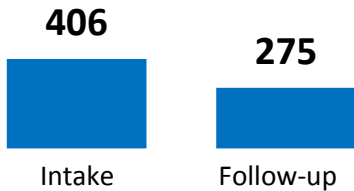
TRIBAL TREATMENT AND RECOVERY INITIATIVE (TOTR)

INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF MICHIGAN

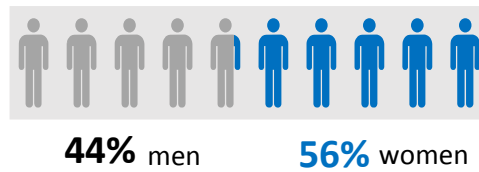
The Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan Anishnaabek Healing Circle Tribal Treatment and Recovery Initiative (TOTR) promotes healing from inter-generational trauma and addiction. TOTR provides resources for clients to access substance abuse treatment and recovery support services. Clients are American Indian/Alaskan Natives with a current opioid use disorder (OUD), ages 12 and older. From July 1, 2017- September 30, 2018, 406 clients with an OUD were enrolled in the program. The results from the program evaluation surveys are highlighted in this report.

Client size **decreased** from intake to follow-up

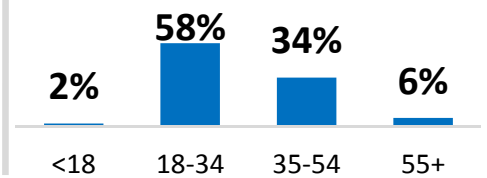


More women than men enrolled in the program

79% experienced any violence or trauma

OF THOSE WHO HAVE EXPERIENCED ANY VIOLENCE OR TRAUMA

8% physically hurt

78% felt numb or detached

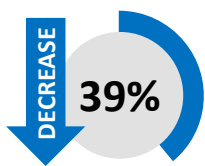
69% had nightmares

83% tried not to think about violence or trauma

71% constantly on guard

KEY OUTCOMES FOR ALL CLIENTS SERVED THROUGH TOTR INITIATIVE

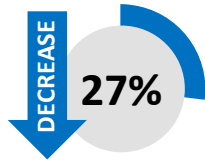
